

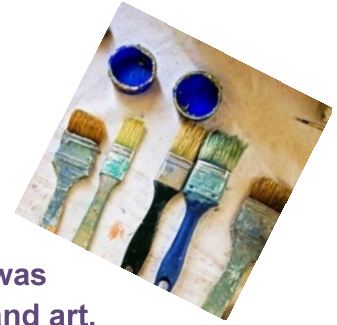

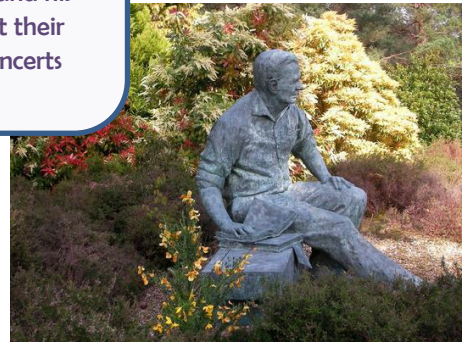


Champs Hill is the home of The Bowerman Charitable Trust which was established in 1984. The Trust seeks to promote classical music and art.
