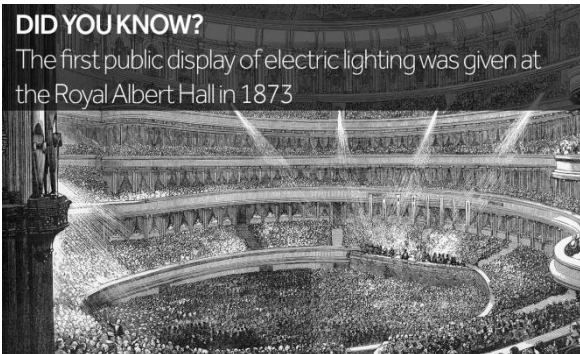

Tour involves stairs

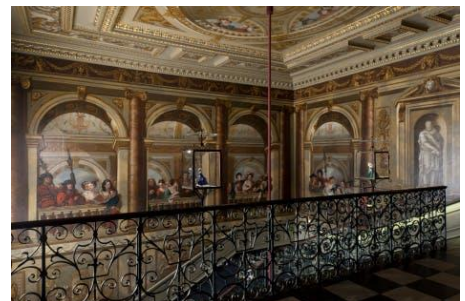
Did you know that the Royal Albert Hall once hosted a séance; flooded the auditorium with 56,000 litres of water for an opera concert; and that criminals, as well as musicians and politicians, have graced the Hall's stage?

See parts of the Hall usually off limits to the public, taking you under the stage, into one of our dressing rooms where all the stars have prepared to perform, and also into the loading bay deep underground. Learn how the show, hospitality and technical teams come together to stage over 390 different events in the main auditorium per year.

### Kensington Palace (You will need to walk through the gardens to the entrance)

#### Victoria: A Royal Childhood

Discover the story of Princess Victoria, the young girl destined to be queen, in the rooms where she was born and raised at Kensington Palace.



This is also the Palace where William III and Mary II, Queen Anne, the Georgians lived; where the modern Royals have a home. Visit the King's State Apartments, walk up the King's Stairs. Find out more about this fascinating Palace's past.

Do enjoy a walk in the formal gardens.
