From 857 the site was owned by a Saxon chief called Led or Leed who built a wooden structure on two islands in the middle of the River Len. Over the centuries it changed ownership, was rebuilt and transformed.


Starting of as a Norman stronghold it was then the private property of six of England's medieval queens; a palace used by Henry VIII and his first wife Catherine of Aragon; a Jacobean country house; a Georgian mansion and an elegant early 20th century retreat for the influential and famous.

The Field of Cloth of Gold'

A series of displays inside the Castle tell the story of the great events that took place in 1520. Find out what role Leeds Castle played.



Risk the **Maze** with its intricate pattern, dead ends and exit through the grotto.
