
Behind the outstanding architecture, the world-class facilities and the friendly atmosphere, you will find pupils from all walks of life achieving and exceeding their potential.





Christ's Hospital

One of the oldest boarding schools in England.

In 1552 the young King Edward VI responded to an impassioned sermon on the needs of London's poor, following which he wrote to the Lord Mayor of London, to set in motion charitable measures to help.

Christ's Hospital was consequently founded in the old buildings vacated by the Grey Friars in Newgate Street and provided food, clothing, lodging and 'a little learning for fatherless children and other poor mens children'. In November 1552, Christ's Hospital opened its doors to 380 pupils and within a year, the number had increased to over 500.

Christ's Hospital moved from the City of London to Horsham in 1902 and is situated in 1,200 acres of stunning Sussex countyside. The School has over 880 pupils with an equal number of boys and girls. 90 percent of pupils are boarders.



Tours are offered on Thursday afternoons during term time and include a historical tour of the School by pupils.

Afternoon tea is served in the School's magnificent dining hall which houses the impressive 87 foot long painting by Antonio Verrio that depicts the School's second Royal Charter granted by Charles II in 1673. It commemorates the founding of the Royal Mathematical School.

How To Book

All tours need to be pre-booked and we welcome groups of up to 30. If you are a smaller group or individual we can combine you with other groups.
