After studying at St Catharine's College, Cambridge and working as music director for the RSC, National Theatre and in London's West End, Sandy Burnett spent a decade as one of the core team of presenters on BBC Radio 3. Combining engaging scholarship with hands-on expertise, he devises and leads cultural holidays all over the world, is the author of the *Idler Guide to Classical Music*, is a highly sought after double bassist on the London jazz scene and was appointed the Academy of Ancient Music's Hogwood Fellow for the 2018-19 season.
